

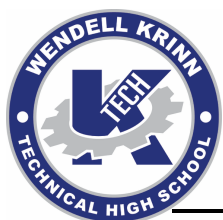

We are investing \$5 million per year in the College Board Opportunity Scholarships, beginning with the class of 2020. This isn't your typical scholarship program. It doesn't require an essay or an application, and it doesn't have a minimum GPA or SAT score requirement. Instead, it rewards all students' efforts and actions on their way to college. 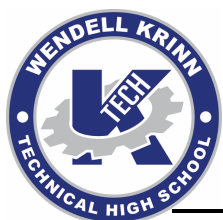

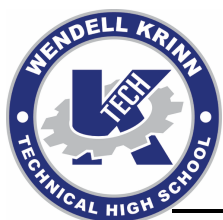
