SENIOR PORTRAITS


Gigante Productions is the official photographer for K-Tech. In order for senior portraits to appear in the yearbook, you *must* be photographed by Gigante.

SENIOR PACKAGE



Senior year can get expensive. In an effort to help spread out the costs associated with senior year, we will be offering a package that includes senior activities and items. This package requires a down payment of \$100 by August 23rd. The balance will be split up into 5 equal monthly payments of \$51.

Payments are due by the 15th of each month from September through January and can be paid on campus with cash or check or online through Acorn. The package is available as-is; no substitutions can be made. There are no refunds on the senior package.
