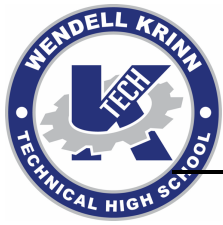

January 16, 2020  Full-Ride Merit Scholarship for Juniors	<b>The Coolidge Scholarship of America</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ 2020 Coolidge Scholarship applicants must intend to enroll full-time at an accredited U.S. college or university as an undergraduate for the first time in fall 2021. That is to say, students in their junior year of high school, or the equivalent if home schooled, are eligible to apply. 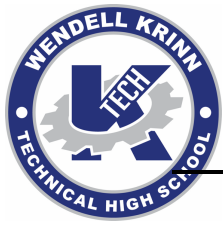

<p>January 30, 2020</p> <p>\$2,500</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>EGIA Foundation</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Students planning to enroll or currently enrolled* in an HVAC technical program** at an accredited institution for the entire 2020-2021 academic year</li> <li>▪ US Citizens, US Nationals, US Permanent Residents</li> <li>▪ Minimum grade point average of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale or equivalent</li> <li>▪ Student pursuing an Associate’s Degree, Certificate, or Diploma in an HVAC technical program</li> <li>▪ Scholarships will be awarded based on eligibility requirements, academic merit, financial need, and interest of pursuing a career in residential HVAC or home performance contracting. <p>January 31, 2020</p> <p>\$4,000</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Legacy Awards</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ For the 2020 contest, any child or grandchild (or step-child, step-grandchild, or legal ward) of a living Elk who joined the order on or before April 1, 2017, or a charter member of a Lodge that was instituted on or after April 1, 2017, is eligible to apply. The Elk must also be a paid-up member through March 31, 2020. Top qualified candidates may be asked to mail an official Florida high school transcript with your school district seal in a sealed enveloped at a later date.</li> <li>▪ Upload a copy of an official SAT and/or ACT scores report</li> <li>▪ Upload two (2) letters of reference (one from school and one from community).</li> <li>▪ Submit an essay (Answer the question: Where Are You Going, Where Have You Been? 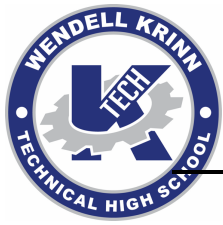
