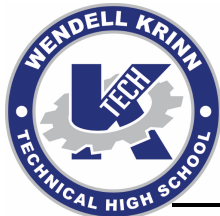

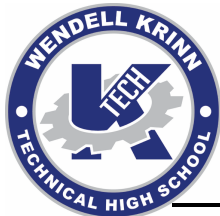

The UPS employee must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Currently reside in Florida and have resided in Florida for the twelve months immediately preceding the application deadline date. • Be employed at UPS at the time the awards are announced. <p><i>*Regular full-time at UPS includes approved leaves of absence with or without compensation for military duty, holding union office, prolonged illness, maternity leave, and personal emergencies.</i></p> <p><i>**A permanent part-time employee is someone who works 15 to 25 hours per week, fills a permanent vacancy and has successfully completed their probationary period. (Union employee – 30 work days and non-union employee – 30 calendar days.)</i></p> <p>Also eligible are children of UPS retirees and deceased UPS employees who were employed with UPS and met the stated employee requirements as of the time of retirement or death. Retirement status as defined by UPS is leaving UPS at the age of 55 or older and receiving retirement benefits from UPS.</p> <p>Applicants must be high school seniors or graduates who plan to enroll or who are already enrolled in full-time undergraduate study at an accredited four-year college or university, community college, state college, or vocational-technical school in Florida. 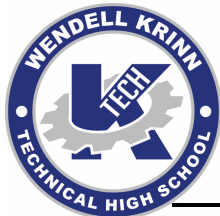

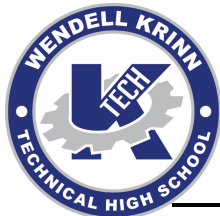

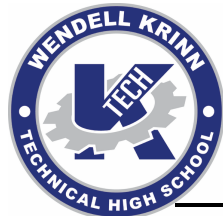
