When is the annual Title I Parent Night?

We typically schedule this meeting in conjunction with our annual Open House to make it convenient for more parents to attend. This meeting is scheduled slightly earlier than Open House is scheduled to begin and has a separate agenda.

What types of things did we spend our Title I funds on for 2019-20?

Based on stakeholder input, we used our Title I funds to pay salary/fringe benefits for an additional discipline assistant, to support our extended day (after school programs), to provide sub coverage and pay travel expenses for teachers to participate in professional development, and to purchase additional technologies.

What did we spend our required 1% for parent/family engagement activities on?

This portion of our Title I funds was used to pay printing and postage costs associated with our three annual Title I Parent University events where parents/families can come learn more about how to better support their students' successes in school.
