

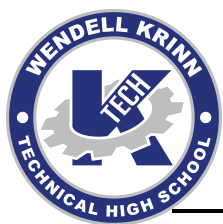

Deadline Amount	Scholarship Information
On-Going \$40,000	<p>A first-of-its-kind national scholarship program that guides students through the college planning process and offers a chance for them to earn money for college for each action completed, beginning with the class of 2020. This isn't your typical scholarship program. It doesn't require an essay or an application, and it doesn't have a minimum GPA or SAT score requirement. Instead, it rewards all students' efforts and actions on their way to college. The more effort that students put in and actions they complete, the more chances they have to earn a scholarship.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">The six steps in this program help students plan by making a good starter list of schools, help them prepare so they can take their best shot, and help them pay for college. Completing each step will earn a chance for a scholarship; completing all six will earn a chance to win \$40K for their college education. T <p>The six actions are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Build Your College List: \$500: Get started by exploring colleges you're interested in.Practice for the SAT: \$1,000: Use Official SAT Practice on Khan Academy to get ready for test day.Improve Your Score: \$2,000: Show how practice pays off by improving your SAT score.Strengthen Your College List: \$500: Make sure your college list has a mix of academic safety, fit, and reach schools.Complete the FAFSA: \$1,000: Fill out the free government form to apply for financial aid.Apply to Colleges: \$1,000: Apply to the schools you want to attend.Complete all six scholarship steps to be eligible for a \$40,000 scholarship. <p>TO APPLY: https://opportunity.collegeboard.org/</p>

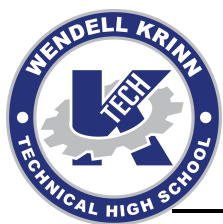

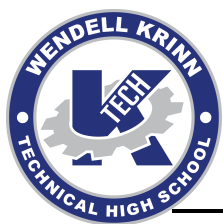

January 31, 2020 \$4,000	Legacy Awards <ul style="list-style-type: none">For the 2020 contest, any child or grandchild (or step-child, step-grandchild, or legal ward) of a living Elk who joined the order on or before April 1, 2017, or a charter member of a Lodge that was instituted on or after April 1, 2017, is eligible to apply. The Elk must also be a paid-up member through March 31, 2020. Great-grandchildren are not eligible.High school senior.If the applicant's parent and grandparent are both Elk members, the applicant must apply through the parent's Elks Lodge.Applicants must take the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) or the American College Test (ACT) in time to receive their scores before the application deadline.If you are selected as a 2020 Legacy Awards recipient, you will be required to perform service once a year with an Elks Lodge during the four years you are receiving the scholarship.
