What types of things did we spend our Title I funds on for 2022-23?

Based on stakeholder input, we used our Title I funds to pay salary/fringe benefits for a parent involvement coordinator, to support our extended day (before and after school programs), to purchase materials/supplies to support recruiting and family engagement events, pay 20% of a social worker's annual salary, to purchase additional technologies, and to provide additional opportunities for staff professional development.

What did we spend our required 1% for parent/family engagement activities on?

This portion of our Title I funds was used to pay printing and postage costs associated with our three annual parent/family engagement events where parents/families can learn more about how to better support their students' successes in school.
